Monday

TBA Scheduled arrival time in Honolulu.

You will be met at the gate and escorted through baggage claim, where you will be presented with the traditional flower lei "Greeting of Aloha". Board your bus for the short ride into Waikiki. *(Please note that you will not be claiming your bags or instruments. They will be transferred by truck to the hotel. This process can take some time, so please be patient).*

Hotel check-in is at 3:00pm – please be patient if room keys are not ready when you arrive. Take some time and explore your surroundings.

3:00pm Hotel check-in and security briefing

Dinner on your own this evening.

8:30pm Director's meeting and reception.

Tuesday

7:00am Buffet breakfast.

8:30am Competition begins at the Waikiki Shell & Kapiolani Bandstand. If applicable your instrument truck will be at the park at 8:00am. Participants will be walking to/from the hotel and Kapiolani Park.

12:30pm Hawaii Invitational Pizza in the park for lunch today during competition.

Dinner on your own this evening.

Wednesday

7:00am Breakfast

9:30am Free time on Waikiki Beach or pursuing individual group interests.

4:45pm Instrument truck at Ft. DeRussy

5:00pm Bus departs hotel for parade line-up at 6:00pm. Parade steps off at 6:30pm on Kalakaua Avenue at Ft. DeRussy, ending at Kapiolani Park, where your bus & instrument truck will be waiting to return you to the hotel (approximately 7:30pm). Open air trolleys are provided for choirs. Please note: Only students/adults marching in the parade will board the bus. Spectators should walk to the viewing area on Kalakaua Avenue in front of the Royal Hawaiian Shopping Center.

8:00pm Dinner on your own this evening.

Thursday

- 5:30am Breakfast
- 6:30am Bus departs for Pearl Harbor and the City of Honolulu tour. While at Pearl Harbor you will visit the USS Arizona Memorial. On the Honolulu City tour you will see Iolani Palace (the only royal palace on US soil), the famous statue of King Kamehameha, the Capital Building, Chinatown and other places of historical interest in Honolulu. **Please note: An on-time departure this morning is essential! Any delay will increase wait time at Pearl Harbor and loss of time for the city tour! Also – no personal items should be brought on tour, purses, backpacks, shopping bags, large camera cases are not allowed at Pearl Harbor for security reasons and the bus company will not accept liability for any personal items left on the bus.**
- 4:00pm Bus departs for Hawaii Invitational Luau at Paradise Cove.

Friday

- 7:00am Breakfast
- Morning free to pursue individual group interests.
- 12:30pm Load instrument truck for final competitions if necessary. Please note that **all** instruments, equipment, uniforms, etc. must be loaded at this time. Following competition truck will proceed directly to the airport. It will not be returning to the hotel. Any forgotten equipment will need to go as checked baggage with the owner and is subject to excess baggage charges if overweight.
- 1:45pm Bus departs hotel for Kamehameha Schools and the final competitions, dinner, exhibition, awards ceremony and dance. Late return to hotel, approximate departure time from Kamehameha is 10:30pm)

Saturday

- 7:00am Breakfast
- Free day in Waikiki, lunch and dinner on your own.

Sunday

- TBA Bag pull. Please place all suitcases on the floor inside the door of your room. Anything you will take with you on the plane (carry-ons, backpacks, purses, etc.) should be placed on the bed. This will let the porters know not to take them.
- 7:00am Breakfast
- TBA Bus departs for Honolulu Airport. When you arrive at the airport, you must claim your luggage and instruments for inspection by the US Agriculture Dept. Once your bags/instruments have cleared inspection you will proceed to the check-in counter to get your boarding passes. All bags must also be cleared by the US Transportation Security Administration prior to receiving your boarding passes.

*****NOTE: Equipment used by the TSA is extremely powerful. Do not put film, exposed or unexposed in your checked suitcase. It should go in your carry-on bag*****
